Dear Local Resident, Interested Citizen, and Elected / Local Public Official:

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will be hosting a Public Information Meeting regarding the proposed road rehabilitation on S.R. 28 (State Street) in Albany from S.R. 28's intersection with S.R. 67 to the bridge over Halfway Creek (0.74 miles east of S.R. 67) in Delaware County. We encourage all attendees to wear masks.

The purpose of the project is to reconstruct the deteriorated existing pavement on this section of S.R. 28. This project will also construct new curb and gutter and sidewalks, as well as provide ADA accessible curb ramps at the intersections through the project limits. Additional storm sewer inlets will be added, and the enclosed storm sewer system will be reconstructed along S.R. 28. The turning radii at intersections will be increased where possible. The "on street" parking on State Street will be replaced but will be unavailable during portions of construction.

The estimated construction cost estimate for the project is \$4,200,000. 41 right-of-way parcels (mainly temporary right-of-way to reconstruct entrances and small right-of-way corner cuts at intersections to construct the new curb ramps) will be affected by the project. The project is scheduled to go to letting in April of 2022.

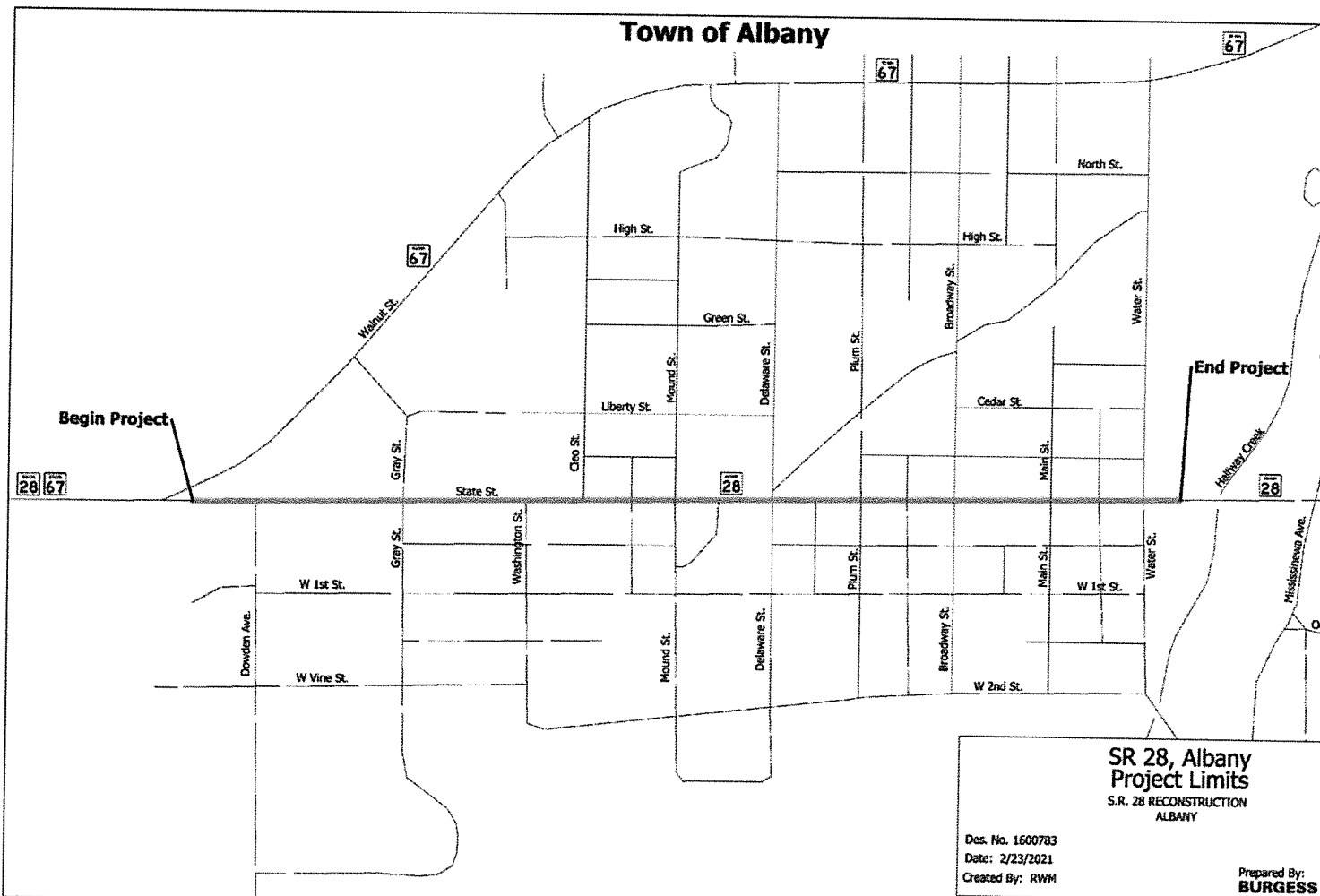
Construction is planned to occur in four separate segments: from the project's beginning at S.R. 67 to Washington Street, from Washington Street to Delaware Street, from Delaware Street to Broadway Street and from Broadway Street to the project's end at the bridge over Halfway Creek. Construction in the downtown area of Albany will be confined to only one side of the road at a time to allow continuous access to businesses. A detour for this section of S.R. 28 along S.R. 67 and S.R. 1 will be in place for the duration of construction.

The traffic signals at S.R. 28's intersections with S.R. 67 and Broadway Street will be maintained. New signal poles will be constructed on the east leg of the S.R. 67 intersection and on all four legs of the Broadway Street intersection. The Broadway Street intersection will also have push button pedestrian signal heads installed as a part of this project. In addition, new railroad signal heads and railroad crossing material will be constructed at the Norfolk & Western Railway Company's crossing at the Delaware Street intersection.
