

KEEPING OR HARBORING OF LIVESTOCK

§ 91.45 WHERE LIVESTOCK PROHIBITED.

No person, firm or corporation occupying real estate within the corporate boundaries of the town shall keep or harbor any livestock or poultry on such property, except where as stated in § 91.46.

§ 91.46 EXEMPTIONS.

A person, firm or corporation occupying real estate within the corporate boundaries of the town whose real estate is zoned as Rural District under the zoning regulations of the town shall have the ability to keep or harbor livestock or poultry on such property. A person, firm or corporation occupying real estate within the corporate boundaries of the town who currently keeps or harbors livestock or poultry on such property shall have the ability to continue to keep and harbor the livestock or poultry on such property and whoever occupies the real estate in the future shall have the ability to keep and harbor livestock or poultry on such property.

§ 91.47 DEFINITION.

For the purposes of this subchapter, **LIVESTOCK** shall mean:

- (A) All cattle or animals of the bovine species;
- (B) All horses, mules, burros and asses or animals of the equine species;
- (C) All swine or animals of the porcine species;
- (D) All goats or animals of the caprine species; and
- (E) All poultry.

§ 91.99 PENALTY.

Any person in violation of these provisions shall be subject to a fine of \$50.
